

St Mary's Graveyard Survey

Before you begin....

This is a document in progress. Some graves have no marker. In these cases we have added the approximate position from the burial records (BR + date) as shown in the lists if known.

Looking for a particular grave....

Find the surname in the *Complete Surname List*.

Eg H A 6 **Young** Mary Croxford 1876

In this example you would find section **H** on the Index map, then look at the section maps to find the **H** section in greater detail then Row **A** followed by the grave number (in this case, number **6**)

Inscriptions in **blue** have been taken from a previous survey in 1914 by A. Weight Matthews which may be seen at the Bedfordshire and Luton Archives and Records service.
Please do not remove these lists from the folder

If you are searching for a name which does not appear on these lists, it does not necessarily mean that person is not present, but some headstones are illegible, incomplete, or have no markers.

Please take care when searching the graveyard. Some areas may be overgrown depending on the time of year. The church community looks after the churchyard but the upkeep of individual graves is the responsibility of the families to whom they belong.
